Kindergarten & Pre-K Registration

The early learning adventure begins here! If you live in our attendance area, we are accepting registrations for Kindergarten, Pre-Kindergarten 4-year old and 3 year-old programs. Requirements:

Kindergarten (no fee) – Monday/Wednesday or Tuesday/Thursday (alternating Friday):

- 1) Must be 5 years of age before December 31.
- 2) Must provide a copy of child's birth certificate.

Pre-K4 (fee \$140/month) – Mon. to Thurs.:

- 1) Must be 4 years of age before December 31.
- 2) Must be potty trained.
- 3) Must provide a copy of child's birth certificate.

Pre-K3 (fee \$75/month) – Tues. & Thurs.:

- 1) Must be 3 years of age before October 15.
- 2) Must be potty trained.
- 3) Must provide a copy of child's birth certificate.
