Before the school day begins ...	
Emergency Contact	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• all parents/guardians must supply the school with 3 emergency contacts who can pick up your child in the event they become ill.• If your child becomes ill during the day they will be placed in an isolation room with an assessment conducted and parent call for pick up
Self Assessment Tool	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• all students and staff must conduct a daily self-assessment prior to entering school. Do not enter the school if you have any symptoms. If you have symptoms please follow AHS self assessment
Arrival at school	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• outside playground is closed prior to the start of the school day• parents are to either stay outside or in their vehicle, all BRSD parents are not allowed to enter the building only by appointment• parents in vehicles can drop off their children in the new student drop off area in our school parking lot see map• students will be greeted by their teacher from 8:15 am - 8:30 am at their assigned door see map• school instruction starts at 8:30 am. If you are late please call the school and someone will meet your child at the front doors.• grade 4 and 5 are asked to wear masks prior to school starting and keep physical distancing• bus students will be greeted by a staff member who will assist them to their classroom entrance door
Breakfast Program	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• will be pre-packed items that will be distributed to classes by a staff member. We are not allowing any outside volunteers.• Breakfast program will start at the beginning of October.

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<p>Classrooms</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> classes will be grouped together in cohorts for instruction and recess. Teachers will move to students when giving teachers prep time or coverage class size will range from 15 - 20 students masks will be worn at the start and end of the day, in hallways and when working in groups for grades 4 & 5 students will require a small ziploc bag to place their mask in when not in use school supplies will not be shared with other students and must be labelled and in pencil cases or ziploc bags. students will be able to take out library books, but they will not be able to go into our Learning Commons. Our Learning Common Facilitator will have a mobile library where students will be allowed to take out max of 2 books from the library for one-week duration. All books will be sanitized upon return. bathroom capacity limited to 2 students at one time from their class cohort 					
<p>Recess</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> some classes eat first, then play; other classes play first, then eat half of the school will be outside at one time classes will have daily designated areas outside to play in 					
<p>Lunch</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> students must eat the lunch that is sent from home, no sharing no deliveries for lunch will be allowed. If lunch is forgotten please call the school office to make arrangements for lunch no outside food for birthdays or class parties 					
<p>Water</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Water bottle filling stations are available for use. Every student should bring a clearly labelled water bottle to school for their personal use. 					
<p>Hygiene</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> students and staff will use hand sanitizer supplied by BRSD or wash their hands when entering the classroom, bathroom, and gym 					

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • a custodian will be on-site to complete mid-morning and mid-afternoon sanitization, daily
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At the end of the school day ...

Dismissal	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students will exit starting at 3:06 pm from the same doors they entered in the morning. • Students will be wearing their masks and maintain physical distancing.
OSCAR	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • OSCAR will be offered this year at Jack Stuart • Those students going to OSCAR will be dismissed from their class last and they will go directly to the stage.
