Hello everyone.

Our school has reported another COVID case today. That makes 3 cases this week.

The most recent case, of which we were notified on Sunday, May 2, has greatly impacted our staffing. We no longer have enough teachers available to provide in-person instruction to all of our students.

As a result, Jack Stuart School has just received approval from Alberta Education to shift all students in Kindergarten to Grade 5 to remote learning for the next two weeks - from Monday, May 3 to Friday, May 14.

Parents, please do not bring your children to Jack Stuart School on Monday morning. Teachers will reach out to their students / families on Monday, with details about how their classes will proceed for the next two weeks.

If teachers let students know there are materials / resources they need to pick up, they will be available at their assigned outside entry door on Monday afternoon, based on this schedule:

Family last name: A to L, 1:00 to 2:00 p.m.

Family last name: M to Z 2:00 to 3 p.m.

We believe this temporary shift will make it possible for quality instruction to continue, and for students and staff to remain well.
