We have been notified that another person connected to our school has tested positive for COVID-19.

This person is a member of one of the cohorts already in quarantine. The new case does not impact additional students, but does require two more staff members to enter quarantine. That brings our total number of staff in isolation / quarantine to 10. This new case also means our school status has been changed by Alberta Health Services from 'Alert' to 'Outbreak'.
