All schools in Alberta are being temporarily shifted to online learning at the end of this week, based on a decision by the Provincial Government. We have been prepared for online learning throughout the school year and can accomplish this transition smoothly. All students know how to access Google Classroom and can do this with minimal assistance.

As our school is already doing online / remote learning, we will continue to provide service to students as we have been doing. The date that we will return to in-person learning at school has been extended for one additional week, to <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>May 25</u>. Here are a few other notes:

- The focus for learning will be on Literacy and Numeracy during this time
- Students in EXCEL can return to in-person learning starting on Monday May 17
- Teachers will be taking attendance during online learning
- Teachers will have scheduled Google Meets with whole class/small groups/individual students, but students/parents can also contact teachers during the regular school hours (8:30 - 3:00)
- Teachers will prepare paper packages for students who require it. Parents can pick up materials on the following schedule:
