Dear Parents/Guardians:

Welcome Back! We are so excited to have your children back to school with us on **Tuesday, September 7!** On Tuesday, August 24, 2021 BRSD sent out their [Back to School Plan](#) which has important information on how school will look this year. We would like to share a few important information items with you specific to Jack Stuart school.

1. Our playground will be closed before school starts. We ask that parents drop off their children between 8:15 and 8:30, as this is when our staff will be ready to welcome children into their classrooms.
2. Each classroom has been assigned a specific door to enter and exit the school for the school year. [JSS Map 2021-2022 with class entrances](#)
3. Please note that there is no parking in the bus lane in front of the school or on Mount Pleasant Drive before and after school hours. Please do not stop or park in the staff section (the part closest to the school), park in the parent section (far east side of the parking lot)
4. Drop off your child on the sidewalk as you enter the parking lot (drop off zone 1) or south end of the parking lot (zone 2 ensure you leave space for other vehicles to continue flow of traffic) or at the crosswalk as you leave the parking lot (drop off zone 3)
5. For the pickup of your child at the end of the day, please meet your child outside their teacher's door and then walk them to your vehicle via the crosswalk. Please do not send your child to the parking lot without adult supervision. We want to ensure our students are safe coming to and leaving school each day. [JSS Parking Lot Map 2021-2022](#)
6. Our doors will remain locked this school year so please call the school 780-672-0880 to book an appointment to meet with your child's teacher or administration.
7. We want to remind you that all food your child brings for snack time and lunchtime should be easy for them to open by themselves so that we can limit the amount of close contact between students and staff. We ask that you explain to your child that they are not to share any food with their classmates.
8. Students and staff are expected to wear masks on school busses, while in high traffic areas - hallways and learning commons. Masks will be worn when physical distancing is not possible (in the classroom when working face to face and/or during group work). Please note your child will not be wearing their mask all day.
