

Dear Jack Stuart School families,

We want to ensure that students arrive safely at school. To that end, we have been working with the BRSD maintenance department and senior leadership to create safe drop off zones for students as well as ensuring a smooth flow for vehicles. Here is an update on our new school drop off/pick up measures.

<u>Drop off on Mount Pleasant Drive:</u> Parents/Guardians can drop off their children on Mount Pleasant drive in front of the school. Concrete barriers have been installed by BRSD to ensure that foot traffic is directed to the designated crosswalk. Our AMA School Safety Patrol will be there to help pedestrians safely cross the bus lane. Please note that vehicles are not to enter the bus lane during the times listed below.





<u>Drop off in the parking lot:</u> We have 3 designated drop off zones in the parking lot. The first one is marked with cones in the morning. Parents/guardians can pull up through the lane marked with pylons, drop their children off and then merge into the traffic flow in the parking lot. There is also a second drop off zone (the south end of the parking lot) and a third zone (by the bike racks). Parents/guardians also have the option to park their vehicles in the east side of the parking lot and walk their children to the crosswalk, where Mrs. Lazaruik or Mr. Sikorski will be on crosswalk patrol.



We'd like to thank all parents and guardians for their cooperation with these new measures. By working together, we can ensure the safety of all of our children.
