A: Yes. All props/costumes/etc need to be provided by the performer. Props will be approved during our screening/audition process.

Q: Will the show be recorded?

A: No

Q: Do students have to submit music in advance?

A: Yes. Music must be child friendly and school appropriate. We must have it in advance so that we can prepare our audio.

Q: Will there be a space provided for performers to get ready before going on stage?

A: Yes. The Pre-K room will be available.

Q: What does an audition/pre-performance meeting look like?

A: We're so excited to see all our students' amazing talents. Auditions are an important part of the process because they give everyone the chance to showcase what they've been practicing. It allows us to make sure each act has the right preparation and support to perform their best.

Screening performances ensures that the show runs smoothly and that we have a balanced variety of acts for our audience. It also helps make sure that the time is used well, so every performer has the opportunity to shine.
